

RATE CONDITIONS FOR INSIDE GRAND CANYON NATIONAL PARK

- Room rates listed are APPROVED rates from the National Park Service and are non-commissionable.
 All rates, dates, surcharges, and taxes are subject to change without notice at any time.
- All final invoices will be billed at the APPROVED rates, regardless of when the reservation was booked, confirmed, or contracted.
- Room rates do not include current 6.9% State Tax.
- Rates are based on single or double occupancy.
- There must be at least one adult (18 years and older) in each room.
- Additional Adult in Room (17 years and older): **\$20** per person per night, plus tax of 6.9%.
- Rollaway beds are **\$20**, plus tax of 6.9% per night, on first-come first-served basis (providing the room reserved can accommodate one).
- Baggage handling is \$8 per person, roundtrip (optional).
- Guest room attendant fee (mandatory) is \$2.25 per person, per night.
- Children age 16 and under stay free when sharing same room and existing bedding with an adult.
- All rooms are Non-Smoking and subject to a cleaning fee of \$175 per room for smoked in rooms.
- Park entry fees not included in room rate and are paid at Grand Canyon National Park entrance station. For more info, visit NPS fees webpage by clicking here.
- Check In: 4:00 PM; Check Out: 11:00 AM

 - o Individual reservations recommended for Arizona Steakhouse and can be made for dinner only online 30 days in advance (click here for more info). Group reservations cannot be made as stated above.
- El Tovar Dining Room (B/L/D) Individual reservations are required for Lunch/Dinner; highly recommended for breakfast and can be made online 45 days in advance (click here for more info).

RATE CONDITIONS FOR GRAND CANYON RAILWAY TRAIN

- Train rates listed above are valid 1/1/25 12/31/25
- Train rates do not include current 10.4% State Tax
- A minimum of twenty (20) paid guests are required for a train group.
- Children age one (1) and under are free when held by an adult ("lap child") and not allowed in Observation Dome.
- Passenger Service Attendant (PSA) Gratuity: \$2 per person for train guests (mandatory)
- Comp Policy: One complimentary train ride for driver and escort based on 20 or more paid guests.
 (PSA gratuity is mandatory and not complimentary)
- NPS Approved Park Entrance Fee:
 - o Groups: 1-9 travelers -\$35
 - o Groups: 10-18 travelers \$70
 - o Groups 19-27 travelers \$105
 - o Groups 28-36 travelers \$140
 - Groups 37-45 travelers \$175
 - o Groups 46-54 travelers \$210
 - Train passengers 15 years or younger = no NPS fee

- NPS Fee is only charged for North bound travel
- Ages:
